Activity Reports:

Stock:

Ric Montoya described the disqualification, appeal and APBA resolution to support the DQ of a C-Stock Runabout contestant at Nationals for an off-spec flywheel.

It was announced that 2010 Mod Divisionals will be shifted to Region 11 in order to pair with Stock Divisionals at Oroville CA on June 4th.

PRO:

Steve Greaves announced that the PRO Commission has approved the shift of PRO Divisionals to Lawrence Lake following the windstorm-forced cancellation of Moses Lake.

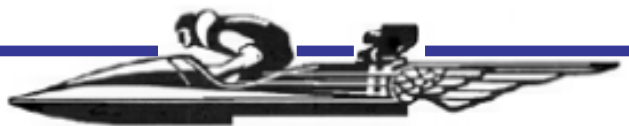

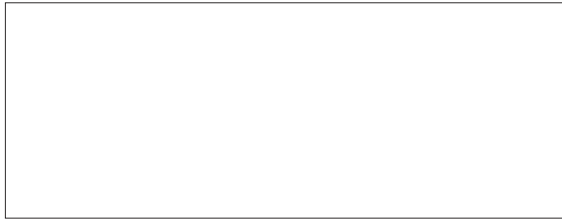
